Living Classrooms

Science & math comprise nearly 30% of the required courses for SACS high school students.

SACS students score significantly above the national average on the SAT and ACT tests.

99% of SACS graduates pursue post-graduate education. They deserve classrooms and labs that will give them the best preparation in their advanced studies.



SACS' new Science & Math Center~located directly behind the football bleachers~will feature state-of-the-art biology, chemistry, physics, and language labs. More than just infrastructure, this full integration of teaching and technology will create both hands-on and minds-on learning crucial for students entering the competitive landscape of college admissions and ultimately the global workforce.

An additional 15 classrooms and five labs ~ 25,000 square feet ~ will enable students to enhance subject mastery, develop scientific reasoning and skills, explore creationism principles, and improve teamwork abilities.

After normal school hours, the second floor classrooms will double as a new press box for football games and "box seats" raffled off to the highest bidder.

Gatherings at the A.F.C. (Arts & Faith Center)

Ask anyone who has had to stand or squeeze into a school event or settle for a makeshift theater, a multipurpose center to fit all those needs is desperately needed at SACS!

Phase One in the renovation of the 14,000 square-foot-space includes adding modern restrooms, repositioning the stage and creating a venue to host:

- Middle and high school chapel services
- Elementary school events, like Grandparent's Day, Texas Day, etc.
- 5th grade graduation
- Family activities
- Drama & band productions
- School assemblies
- Seating for up to 700 people

Phase Two

The arts touch every other academic area and are as basic to a great education as reading and writing. In light of this fact, the long-term goal is to:

- Add a new 6,000 sq.ft. building for drama, band & choir classrooms
- Expand and enlarge the stage
- Add a food service building to serve as additional cafeteria & event concessions

Also included in this campaign are the improvements already underway in the elementary school. The addition of two new classrooms will accommodate SACS growing enrollment.
